Yom HaShoah is Holocaust Memorial Day, commemorating the Jews killed by the Nazis. It is a goal of the commemoration to provide participants with the opportunity to remember those who perished in the Shoah, honor our survivors and teach this period of history to the next generation, who will be responsible for carrying on the legacy. This year's theme is Children of the Holocaust with keynote speaker Teresa Fischlowitz. The program will also include members of the JCC's J*Company, musical selections and candlelighting by local survivors and their families along with video interviews with child survivors.
